Wachau World Heritage Site

Picturesque villages, vineyards and orchards, stone walls, species-rich dry grasslands, mixed forests and vantage points line the Danube valley in the 36 kilometre-long Wachau. This unique cultural landscape has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2000. The important baroque abbots of Melk and Göttweig, churches and 20 castles, fortresses and ruins tell the rich, centuries-long history. The lively present is characterised by cultural events, exhibitions and enjoyable leisure activities. The Wachau is also one of the most valuable natural areas in Europe and is a European Diploma and nature reserve.

50 World Heritage Spots

A special highlight of the Wachau World Heritage Trail are the 50 finely curated World Heritage Spots along the route, which focus on the special features of the World Heritage Site. Each of these World Heritage Spots is labelled with a QR code. With a simple scan, interested visitors can receive exciting information directly on their mobile phones and experience the fascinating history and cultural and historical treasures of the Wachau on the spot. Each stage reveals new insights and stories that make this region so special.

Cycling in the region

The Danube Cycle Path is part of Eurovelo6 and is one of the most beautiful cycle routes in Europe. The total length is 1200 km, around 260 km lead along the Danube through Lower Austria. The MTB Arena Wachau-Jauring, the Trailarena Göttweig and the MTB tours in the Nibelungengau offer mountain bike experiences at all levels of difficulty.
